

2018 Turley "Bechtoldt Vineyard" Cinsault, Lodi

Planted in 1886, this Cinsault vineyard is the oldest of its kind in the country—perhaps even beyond. The vines are gnarly, head-trained and planted on their own roots in deep, sandy soils. Aged in 100% used French oak.

Spiced cherry, fresh white plum, and blood orange notes soar from the glass. Fresh, lip-smacking medium-plus acidity and deceptively lighter on the palate than previous vintages, but still with great power. The Cinsault always has the unique depth and complexity that can only be found in a wine from truly ancient vines. We find this wine most enjoyable when served with a slight chill (at cellar temperature or just below) during the warm months.
