

2019 Turley "Estate Vineyard" Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley

Though a recent addition to the Turley family, Sauvignon Blanc was one of the first wines ever made from the Turley Estate in 1993. Those vines have since been replaced by Zinfandel, but we have replanted a small section of the estate to dryfarmed, head-trained Sauvignon Blanc from heritage Napa Valley budwood once again. Get while the getting's good though—Larry is hoarding as much as possible for himself, and sharpening his oyster shucker as we speak!

Bright, honeyed stone fruits such as white nectarines and apricots, as well as a bit of sun-warmed citrus on the nose. The palate of the '19 Sauvignon Blanc shows a hair more heft & chutzpah than years past, with a satiating multidimensional texture. Since this is a young wine, we recommend allowing the bottles a moment to catch their breath (at least a few weeks?) before you open
