

2018 Turley "Estate Vineyard" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

This wine checks all the boxes: certified organically-farmed, single-vineyard, estate-owned, pure Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon! An aggregate rarely found in our corner of the world for less than \$150 a bottle. You truly could not ask for more from this wine, whose vines were planted in 1989 on the volcanic and alluvial soils on the eastern edge of the Turley estate.

We picked the 2018 Estate Cabernet five times between September 28th and October 27th. It's rare to harvest one vineyard over the course of a month in Napa, but we took a page from Alain Graillot in the Rhône Valley — a domaine whose wines we've long admired and where our winemaker Tegan Passalacqua worked a harvest in 2005— and the wine is all the better for it! Picking at slightly different points in the fruit's maturity allows for a natural, layered complexity to develop. The wine opens with vivid bright red-toned fruits, moves on to savory Napa garrigue and well-integrated velvety tannin, and culminates in a mouthwatering, umami-rich, lingering finish. This wine is ready to drink on release, no need to decant; just pop, pour, and let the pleasure abound!
