Purchasing 5 Reading Partners from Volunteer Reading Scheme to promote love of reading and communication and make accelerated progress in reading.

Music Tuition was purchased for year 4 children.

Subsidy for residential trip to Oaklands for relevant children.

Subsidy for, school trips and school excite days.

Continued development of the Creative Curriculum to excite, enthuse and motivate children to inspire learning.

Employment of a Speech and Language Therapist to develop speech and language in identified children.

TAs trained to develop speech and language strategies

Teacher and TAs trained to support EAL pupils
