

Sport at St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School

Physical Education and Sports Funding 2014/15

This academic year St. Joseph's received £9,775 of government funding to assist with PE and School Sport. Jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health & Culture, Media and Sport, this funding is "ring fenced" and can only be spent on PE and Sports provision in our school.

The aim of this funding is to assist improvements in Physical Education and sport for all our children and at St. Joseph's we have decided that it should be spent in the following ways:

- To fund three qualified members of PE staff from Bebington High Sports College to provide lessons every Thursday afternoon. Every class in the school will be provided with half a term's provision. Additional to this is inset and lesson plans for each class teacher in the school. Bebington High staff will also carry out an assessment of every child they teach.

Cost: £5000

- To fund a qualified member of PE staff from St. John Plessington to provide lessons fortnightly. Every class in the school will be provided with half a term's provision. Additional to this is inset and lesson plans for each class teacher in the school.

Cost: £2000

- To fund a package for Year 6, provided by Tranmere Rovers FC, linking dance, fitness, football, English and Maths. The Year group will visit Prenton Park to take part in activities such as sports journalism, football themed Mathematics and dance workshops. This has been provided for a number of years now and will continue, so that every child in the school will be able to take advantage of this as they pass through Year 6.

Cost: £1,500

Remaining fund:

- To release Mr Nayland where necessary and provide costs to enable pupils to participate in school cluster competitions in athletics, cricket, cross country, dance, football, netball and rounders.
- To purchase "Active Playground" equipment for Midday Assistants to provide structured lunchtime activities for Key Stage 1.
- To subsidise 'Pupil Premium' children, enabling more participation in sport / Outdoor Adventurous Activities such as intra-school competitions and Oaklands.
- To renew sports equipment outside the Sainsbury's Active Kids range.
