Summer Term 2015, Autumn Term 2015 and Spring Term 2016. • To purchase 3 Reading Partners from Volunteer Reading Scheme, to assist identified pupils to make progress in Reading and to promote a love of Reading. • To continue to subsidise the cost of a range of learning experiences and provide all pupils with a variety of creative learning opportunities to motivate and inspire pupils; e.g. 'Wizard of Oz.' M and M Theatre Company. (June 15) Y6 Residential trip to Oaklands Outdoor Centre in North Wales, (Oct. 15) Pantomime 'Dick Whittington.' M and M Theatre Company. (Spring Term 16)

Monitoring and Evaluation of PPG Expenditure.

Monitoring and Evaluation will focus on the development of pupils' self esteem, confidence, interests and attitude to learning and progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.

- Carry out Baseline Assessments for identified pupils at the start of each term. Classteacher/SENCO/Teaching Assistant.
- Termly Meeting of Classteacher, SENCO and Teaching Assistant to discuss and plan delivery of an intervention programme if required.
- Termly Progress Meeting to discuss and evaluate progress of identified pupils. SMT/Classteacher, SENCO/Teaching Assistant.
- Use of planned termly 'Parents Evening' Appointment to discuss and evaluate pupil progress. Classteacher/Parent.
