We have traditionally had the numerical count reflect the total number of days included in the 180 day count (*which includes both whole and half-days*), and color coded the half days so parents have a visual reminder of when those days are scheduled. So, on the current calendar, the total count of days in each month includes the half-days.

We count four professional learning/teacher preparation days as part of the 180 day student total, per Utah state code 53F-2-102. On this calendar those days are on August 14, August 22, October 11, and February 2. These are days where students do not attend school, but the days count as part of the 180 day calendar.

We count three days used for parent conferences/communication as part of the 180 day student total, per USBE Administrative Rule R277-419-6. Two of these days are "*compensatory days*" for time spent in schedule parent-teacher conferences. The other day is off-contract time that teachers use to do personalized outreach to targeted students and their families. Students do not attend school on these three day, but they are included in the accounting of 180 school days.

In January 2022, the 990 hour requirement outlined in R277-4-6 was removed permanently. With that removal, schools are able to focus on the 180 day requirement instead of the 990 hours, thereby providing additional time for teachers to build their skills and plan the personalized support students need.

In summary, there are 173 regular school days on the calendar (accounting for both full and half-days), four (4) professional development/teacher work days that count as school days, and the equivalent of three (3) parent conference/communication days that count as school days, which are not reflected on the calendar, for a total of 180 school days.
