## **REPORTS/ DISCUSSION/ ACTION**

**Discussion:** Eric Markworth shared successes surrounding the New Teacher Onboarding program. Instructional coaches shared what additional supports are given to teachers new to the Logan City School District to provide success throughout the year. New teachers shared how these supports contributed to a successful first year.

**Discussion:** Director of Secondary Schools, Liz Dickenson, offered an opportunity for Board members to ask questions regarding World Language and Health education curriculum. This curriculum is available to view for the next few weeks at the district office.

**Action:** Superintendent Schofield reviewed the proposed lease agreement with Boys and Girls Club for the annex building near Mount Logan Middle School. The lease agreement was approved and voting was unanimous.

**Action:** A motion was made to reappoint Jeff Barben, LCSD Business Administrator for two additional years. Approval was unanimous.

**Action:** More information is needed to approve the budget for the Indoor Athletic Complex. This will be brought before the Board at a future meeting.

**Action:** A new formula to determine transportation costs has been developed as part of the district partnership with Cache County School District. Approval for an increase in the transportation budget for student busing was unanimously approved.

**Action:** The Board unanimously approved the updated budget for the Outdoor Learning Center. This facility will welcome students beginning the fall of 2024.

**Action:** Final approval was given to Policy DO - Teacher Employment Status & Immigration Policy. Policy FAC Student Use of Cell Phones was presented for a first reading.
