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REPORTS/ DISCUSSION/ ACTION

Discussion: Director of Secondary Schools, Liz Dickenson, introduced Mount Logan Middle School teachers, Angela Wyatt and Raychel Jensen as well as Jessica Krebs and Dave Henderson from Logan High School who shared information about the English Language Arts Curriculum in the secondary schools. This curriculum is available to review for the next couple of weeks at the district office.

Action: School Land Trust Plans were approved for all schools for the 2024-2025 school year. Voting was unanimous. Appreciation to all of the administrators and community councils was expressed for all the efforts made to create these plans.

Action: Facilities Manager Don Bell presented the capital expenditure list for the upcoming year. It was approved and voting was unanimous.

Action: The budget for the Indoor Athletic Complex was presented by Business Administrator Jeff Barben. With bids being higher than expected, and efforts made to mitigate cost, final bids were shared. The presented budget was approved unanimously.

Action: The Board gave final approval for the proposed Elementary Language Arts curriculum (CKLA). Voting was unanimous.

Action: The Board gave final approval for the proposed World Languages and Sex Education Secondary Curriculums. Voting was unanimous.

Action: Approval was given for a LEA specific license in the area of CTE for the remainder of the school year. Voting was unanimous.

Action: Revision to Art Endowment Fund Language to include a fund to be used for a variety of student experiences including travel, equipment etc was presented. Voting was unanimous.

Action: Information regarding Policy FAC Student Use of Cell Phones will be sent to patrons in coming days to provide opportunities for feedback prior to final approval.
