- 2. Detailed cover letter outlining special competencies related to and specific interest in the particular position
- 3. Current resume in which professional preparation and experience are clearly detailed
- 4. Three letters of recommendation written within the last six months
- 5. Transcripts of all college and university credits
- 6. Most recent teaching evaluation

Qualifications

- Current Utah Teaching License
- Experience in an educational leadership role preferred (e.g., department chair, team leader, mentor teacher, etc.)
- Demonstrated knowledge of and ability to apply the Logan City School District PLC Model/Framework and instructional non-negotiables
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with principal, teachers, parents, and other professionals as a coach and mentor

- Ability to coordinate services and programs with various staff members, facilitate group interactions, and conduct professional study groups
- Demonstrated exceptional interpersonal skills and high level of collaboration with peers and school leaders
- History of continued education and evidence of willingness to learn and grow professionally
- Knowledge of Utah State Curriculum Standards
- Expertise in providing professional development and training for adult learners

Essential Functions

- Works in conjunction with building principal and the district instructional team (e.g., Instructional Coaches, Teacher Specialists, Principals, and District Directors) to improve instructional practices and student learning
- Collaborates with teachers and other school leaders to bring effective, evidence-based instructional practices to the classroom
- Utilizes the instructional coaching process in one-on-one and small group settings to provide support to teachers and school leaders in implementing evidence-based instructional strategies for the purpose of increasing student engagement, improving student achievement, and building teacher capacity
- Creates a positive, professional environment conducive with district initiatives
- Works with the district instructional team to provide and/or arrange for professional development for all teachers
- Builds relationships with teachers by working in a confidential, non-evaluative, and supportive manner
