Welcome & General Information-

Madeline made a motion to approve the November minutes with corrections. Rico seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Community Resources List Proposal for Community Alliance Website – Mayor Darryl Grennell spoke on different examples of why a community resource list would be beneficial for our community. Discussion continued on how Community Alliance could implement this project. Lindsey made a motion to tweak the Community Alliance website to fill this need and to take this on as a Community Alliance project. Rico seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Civil Rights Trail Project – The Historical Natchez Foundation (Mimi Miller) applied for a \$200,000 grant from the National Park Service for development of a thematic national historic registry for civil rights sites in Adams County. They received \$50,000. The proposed CA role would be to raise a community match goal of \$10,000 to manufacture and install 5 interpretive panels. The panel locations will be determined by a HNF civil rights project committee & community meetings. Lindsey made a motion that Community Alliance adopt this project as the 2017 project. Barbara seconded the motion. Motion passed.
