A Mindful Christmas

In Family Chapel this week, we assembled the figures of the crèche by first bringing the animals to the stable, then Mary and Joseph, the baby Jesus, shepherds, and angels. We also lit the first candle of the Advent Wreath. The unlit candles remind us that we are not yet celebrating Christmas. We must pass the days of Advent, lighting one candle each week, before we can truly celebrate the nativity. How nice it is to have these days of anticipation, while all around us the world is "celebrating" early! It is hard to feel that what we're doing shopping, decorating, baking, partying, moving the Elf-is celebratory when it drags us down with obligation and drudgery. By all means, if it brings you joy, do it! Our children can teach us a great deal, though, about the joy of anticipation. The

waiting itself can make the arrival of Christmas all the sweeter.

Christmas Day is only day one of the season. Christmas lasts for 12 days, ending on the eve of the Epiphany (when we'll bring out the 3 Kings for the crèche). My challenge for you is to find a way to celebrate Christmas all 12 days. (It's easier to do this when you haven't begun early.) This doesn't mean a gift every day, at least not the kind that is wrapped up with a bow, but it could be the gift of time and presence. Consider giving your child an hour of one-on-one play with a favorite game, taking a drive to see Christmas decorations, letting him/ her choose the menu for dinner, having a special privilege....you get the picture. Begin each day of the season with a recognition that "This is the 2^{nd} (or 3^{rd} , or 4^{th} ...)



day of Christmas. Maybe you'll want to have a "Twelfth Night" party for family or friends on January 5th. Taking your tree down on Epiphany is a common practice; again, this is easier if it hasn't been up since Thanksgiving.

However you choose to celebrate the season of Advent and Christmas, I hope you do it with intentional practices. Take the time to be mindful about what will make this time sacred for you and your family.
