



Please note the current requirements for entry & exit to and from Kenya:

ON ARRIVAL:

Travelers above the age of 12 years (arriving through any entry point) will be required to show proof of either **full Covid-19 Vaccination**, or a **negative PCR test** conducted more than 72 hours prior to departure from home country, regardless of route of entry.

There will be **no paper verification** of vaccination certificates & COVID-19 test results upon arrival into Kenya.

***Prior to arrival in Kenya**, all travelers are required to submit their vaccination certificate or PCR test result the trustedtravel.panabios.org website

*Fully vaccinated means having received the prescribed doses of a specific vaccine, the latest shot of which must be at least 14 days prior to arrival (not including the date of vaccination)

*Travelers below the age of 12 shall be exempt from the vaccination and PCR test requirements.

Any traveler above the age of 12 arriving at any point of entry with no proof of vaccination or a PCR test, or those with flu-like symptoms shall be subjected to a rapid antigen test at their own cost of USD 30. Any person who tests positive on rapid antigen test will be subjected to a PCR test at a further cost of USD 50 and will be required to self-isolate as per the Ministry of Health's guidance on isolation. Travelers below the age of 12 are exempt from this testing requirement.

With effect from 1st September 2022, only travelers arriving (at any point of entry) with flu-like symptoms will be expected to fill in the passenger locator [COVID-19 Travellers Health Surveillance Form](#) on the Jitenge Platform. Passengers should use this link, or alternatively download the “**Jitenge**” App (available on the Google Play Store). They will be required to take a PCR test on arrival at their own cost.

ON DEPARTURE:

Passengers travelling out of Kenya will be required to abide by the particular travel, health and COVID-19 related requirements of the destination country. Pre-departure testing may be considered at the discretion of any of the airlines departing from or terminating in Kenya.

Please ensure you check your airline and return destination Covid Test requirements as these may differ from Kenyan requirements – it is important that you share this information with us prior to your visit, so that we can ensure we book the correct test for you, prior to your departure.
