STALL DEPOSIT SYSTEM

Following several complaints about empty stalls or stalls being used for tack, YAS has implemented a deposit fee system of £50.00 per stall booked. The deposit fee will be refunded AT SHOW to those exhibitors whose pre-booked stalls are occupied by their pre-booked cattle and not tack.

Caravans/Motorhomes can be brought to the show **after 2pm on Friday 6th July**. Exhibitors must vacate the park **by 5pm on Friday 13th July**.

You should display the permit at all times as the parks will be regularly monitored for caravans and motorhomes without permits.

STALL CANCELLATIONS:

ALL stall cancellations must be received in writing (fax, email or post) in the Livestock & Entries Office by 5pm on Friday 15th June 2018 for stall refunds to be paid. Confirmation of receipt from the office is advised. After that date a partial refund of 50% may be agreed providing the stall can be resold.

PUBLICITY AND DATA PROTECTION – see Reg. 52, Cattle & Sheep Schedule

In order to process your entry form YAS is required to digitally store your personal information. If you do not wish your personal information to be stored in this way, we will be unable to process your entry. If you wish to proceed under these rules YOU MUST TICK THE BOX ON PAGE 2 OF THE ENTRY FORM

ENTRIES – entry close date Tuesday 15th May 2017– You can enter as many animals as you wish but can only bring animals for which you have booked a stall. This gives you flexibility at the point of leaving your farm to bring the animals that are looking their best. Substitutions are NOT ALLOWED AFTER Tuesday 22nd May.

ENTRY SUBSTITUTIONS – Last date for substitutions is 5pm Tuesday 22nd May. Your written/email/faxed instructions should be received by the Livestock & Entries Office before 5pm Tuesday 22nd May. Always ask for confirmation that your instruction has been received.

ENTRY CANCELLATION & REFUNDS – Last date for cancellations is 5pm Friday 22nd June
Your written/email/faxed instruction should be received by the Livestock & Entries Office before 5pm Friday 22nd June. Refund for cancelled entries will only be given for veterinary reason and supported by a veterinary certificate. Always ask for confirmation that your instruction has been received.

CATTLE STALLS – can only be booked on the entry form

This year the Great Yorkshire Show will host the National Shows for both British Charolais cattle and British Simmental cattle. This will impact on stall bookings so please book your stalls early to avoid disappointment. **STALLS ARE LIMITED TO 4 PER BREED**. If you want your cattle to be stalled next to a specific exhibitor (must be same breed), please write this on your cattle entry form or attach a note to the form – a telephone call to the office requesting is not sufficient.

NEW THIS YEAR – Following several complaints from exhibitors that there were empty stalls in the sheds, or stalls being used for tack, it has been decided to implement a deposit fee system per stall. i.e. stall fee + £50.00 deposit. The deposit will be refunded at Show to exhibitors whose pre-booked stalls are occupied by their pre-booked cattle and not tack etc.

STALL CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS – last date for stall cancellation is 5pm Friday 15th June
Your written/email/fax cancellation instruction should be received by the Livestock & Entries Office before 5pm Friday 15th June in order to receive a full refund for a stall so that we can offer the stall to any exhibitors who may be on the waiting list. Cancellations requested after this time/date may be able to have a 50% refund.

THE CATTLE STALLING PLAN This plan is designed to ensure the timely, safe and most efficient movement of animals from the stalls to the showing rings. Please do not move or change exhibitor cards that have been put above stalls as this causes several types of difficulty and much ill-feeling for other exhibitors. Anyone found to have moved cards may be subject to future restrictions.

CATTLE PARADE – Exhibitors whose animals are prize-winners and who parade their animals on Thursday have the opportunity of winning a £100 cash prize.

CLIPPING CRATES – **Clipping Crates will not be allowed in any of the sheds**. A new clipping area has been established for a limited number of crates. Any exhibitor wishing to bring a clipping crate must register their interest in writing to the Livestock Office for approval. Unapproved crates will have to be removed immediately by the exhibitor from the Showground.

ANIMALS ENTERED IN THE BEEF CLASSES MUST BE ON THE SHOWGROUND BY 4PM ON MONDAY 9TH JULY & REMAIN THERE UNTIL 4PM THURSDAY 12TH JULY
