CFSGBI Members Conference Bursary

Terms and Conditions of application

- Successful recipients of a bursary will receive the full registration fee for the three day conference.
- There will be a total of five bursaries available.
- Applicants must have been a paid member of the Society as of the previous year's conference.
- Applicants should work within or be linked to a recognised cleft team/service within the UK.
- A brief letter of support, signed by a lead clinician at a cleft centre, should also be submitted along with the application to confirm the applicant is actively involved in cleft care in the UK.
- The submission of an abstract for presentation or poster is not a pre-requisite for application but will be taken into consideration when applications are assessed.
- Successful applicants will be expected to submit a report following the conference. This will be made available on the CFSGBI website.

How to apply:

Please submit a 200 - 300 word application to introduce yourself, giving reasons as to why you should be considered for the bursary and how attending the conference will help and support you. Please also state if you have made any other applications for funding (e.g. study leave budget, grant, charities bid etc.), giving any relevant details. Please include your current post/position, including banding if relevant.
