The Art Gallery Presents: Still Fighting For Our Lives Archives Exhibit

November 10– December 29

Opening Reception: Friday, November 10: 5:30-8:00 pm

On September 25, 1986, thousands walked silently by candlelight through the streets of Philadelphia to raise awareness of the plight of AIDS in our community. Those in attendance marched to mourn hundreds of losses, stand by those living with the disease, and demand the attention that the growing epidemic deserved. Organizers raised money for the event by selling t-shirts emblazoned in black and white with the phrase "Fighting For Our Lives." The money left over went to the founding of the Philadelphia AIDS Library, an institution which has steadfastly served the community for 30 years now. This exhibit, highlighting the Philadelphia AIDS Library Graphics Collection, explores the history of HIV/AIDS in Philadelphia. Despite great strides made in the prevention and treatment of the disease, it still threatens many, including some of the most vulnerable members of our community. For this reason we are "Still Fighting For Our Lives."

Rainbow Reading Book Club: WHAT BELONGS TO YOU by Garth Greenwell

On an unseasonably warm autumn day, an American teacher enters a public bathroom beneath Sofia's National Palace of Culture. There he meets Mitko, a charismatic young hustler, and pays him for sex. He returns to Mitko again and again over the next few months, their relationship growing increasingly intimate and unnerving. As he

struggles to reconcile his longing with the anguish it creates, he's forced to grapple with his own fraught history: his formative experiences of love, his painful rejection by family and friends, and the difficulty of growing up as a gay man in southern America in the 1990s. Startlingly erotic and immensely powerful, *What Belongs to You* tells an unforgettable story about the ways our pasts and cultures, our scars and shames can shape who we are and determine how we love. Join our book club for commitment-phobes. Each month has a new genre and many titles are available for free. Come every time or drop in when the selection intrigues you. Every text is LGBTQ-related and readers will be invited to discuss them in person and online beforehand.
