Day 1 July 1, Sunday: Depart USA

Depart New York from John F. Kennedy International Airport on Delta for our overseas journey to France.

Complimentary dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served. (D,B)

Day 2 July 2, Monday: Arrive in France | Lisieux

Arrive in Paris at Charles de Gaulle International Airport. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tour Manager will meet us as we exit from Customs. Board our private tour bus, and we will be on our way to Lisieux. Independent lunch in Lisieux. Then, visit the astonishing **Basilica of St. Thérèse and celebrate Mass in the Crypt Chapel**. Time will be given for prayer and reflection.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux. (D)

Day 3 July 3, Tuesday: Excursion to Mont Saint-Michel

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we depart on a full day excursion to the northwestern coast at the mouth of the Couesnon River near Avranches. As we approach this tiny island, by a causeway built in 1877, we will enter the medieval village of 250 inhabitants by three massive stone gates. Upon arrival, visit the beautiful monastery of Mont Saint-Michel. Surrounded by the sea and soaring proudly above glistening sands, the silhouette of Mont-Saint-Michel is one of the most enchanting sights in all of France. The great Benedictine Abbey Fortress that crowns this mass of granite was begun in 1017. A monastery built on three levels was added to the church's north side in the early 13th century. **Celebrate Mass at the Abbey**. Independent lunch with time will to browse and shop. Late afternoon, return to hotel.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

Day 4 July 4, Wednesday: Independence Day in Normandy | D-Day Landing Beaches

Buffet breakfast at hotel. We will spend this Fourth of July visiting the D-Day Landing Beaches. On June 6, 1944 tens of thousands of American, English, Canadian, Scots and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy coast to free France from the Nazi stronghold. The coast of Normandy still has the indelible scars of that event. Our visit begins with a stop at Benouville's bridge, mostly known as Pegasus Bridge. See the Arromanches where the maritime vestiges made the greatest artificial port ever created. All the armored vehicles, trucks, supplies, and soldiers came into France through this port. Independent lunch. After lunch we will visit Omaha Beach, the most famous of the Normandy Landing Beaches. We will conclude our visit at the American cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer, where a multitude of young soldiers are buried, and prayerfully remember those who sacrificed their lives for freedom. **Witness the flag lowering ceremony and taps, followed by Mass in the Cemetery Chapel**. Return to Lisieux and freshen up for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

Day 5 July 5, Thursday: Alençon | Chartres

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Today, we leave Normandy for Chartres. En route we will stop in the town of Alençon to visit Notre Dame Church where the parents of St. Thérèse were married. Visit the house where Thérèse was born in Rue Saint Blaise. Her father, Louis, was a successful watchmaker and jeweler. Her mother Zélie (Guerin) Martin built a cottage industry in lace making, beginning in the village of Alençon, which is known for its delicate lace. Late morning, we continue to Chartres. Independent lunch en route. The Cathedral spires of Chartres can be seen from miles away, seeming to rise out of the wheat fields of the Beauce Plains. Visit Notre Dame Cathedral, the jewel in the crown of medieval churches in Europe and a testimony in stone to the religious fervor of the Middle Ages. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained-glass windows. The Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres also houses the *Sancta Camisia*, a tunic that tradition says belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary. **Celebrate Mass in the Crypt of the Cathedral**. After Mass, check-in at hotel in Chartres. Dinner at hotel in Chartres. **After dusk (10:00 pm), enjoy the Chartres Light Show. Beautiful and colorful light illumines historic buildings of Chartres, while music accompanies the dynamic light show.**

Overnight at hotel in Chartres. (B,D)

Day 6 July 6, Friday: Pilgrim Churches of Paris & Montmartre | Seine River Cruise

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we leave Chartres to Paris. Upon arrival in Paris we visit Rue de Bac Shrine of the Miraculous Medal, where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in 1830. Continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul where the saintly remains are preserved and venerated. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine**. Next, we continue to Ile de la Cité, where you will visit the magnificent cathedral, Notre-Dame-de-Paris. Its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows will take your breath away. Continue to visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of Flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité in Paris. Discover its unique stained glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the Heavenly Jerusalem. End our morning at Montmartre to visit to the fascinating Artist Square and Sacré Coeur Basilica, with its huge bell tower and onion-shaped domes-one of the city's most familiar sights. This gleaming white church rises atop Montmartre, Paris' highest hill at 423 feet. Independent lunch in Montmartre and afternoon at leisure. This is your opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Paris all on your own! There are always plenty of churches, museums to explore. This is the time to hit high fashion spots, as well as the local shops and street vendors. Paris is yours! Perhaps you would like to visit the Louvre Museum, with nearly 60,000 square meters of exhibition space to house its vast collection. Dinner at a restaurant in Paris. **This evening, enjoy a panoramic cruise on the Seine River**. In one single boat ride we will view historic architecture that spans a thousand years. Be on the lookout for 25 bridges and the many great illuminated monuments of Paris!

Overnight at hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 7 July 7, Saturday: Highlights of Paris | Flight to Lourdes

Early buffet breakfast at hotel. After checking out of the hotel, our guide will bring alive the remarkable sights of Paris: Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, the Opéra the Bastille Square and The Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris. Then, continue to Charles de Gaulle Airport for our afternoon continuing flight to Lourdes. Arrive in Pau Pyrenees Airport near Lourdes, collect our luggage and board our private coach. As we arrive in Lourdes we will see the picture book castle near the grotto where the "Beautiful Lady" appeared to Bernadette. The shrine is more dramatic and larger than most expect. We will meet pilgrims from all over the world who seem imbued with a loving spirit that charges the atmosphere. At night, joyful singing fills the narrow streets. Laughter is woven with prayer. Pilgrims come from all nations. Whether visitors experience a healing miracle or not, most say the miracle becomes simply being in Lourdes. Check-in at hotel and freshen up for Mass. **Before dinner, celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Poor Clare Sisters. After dinner this evening, join in the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary and singing Hymns to the Mother of God.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 8 July 8, Sunday: Lourdes Walking Tour

Breakfast at our hotel. **Mass at the Grotto** (To be confirmed. Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.) This morning, participate in the walking tour of Lourdes where the group will visit the places associated with the life of Bernadette. These locations include the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch. Independent lunch and free day for private devotions. **Baths are open 8:30 am - 12:30 pm / 1:30 pm - 6:00 pm on weekdays. The Blessed Sacrament procession is held daily at 5:00 pm. During the procession there are meditations, prayers, hymns and chants, in several languages. When all the participants have assembled, there follows a period of Eucharistic Adoration, and the Blessing of the Sick. The Chapel of Reconciliation is open daily. After dinner, join in the Torchlight Marian procession, praying the Rosary and singing hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 9 July 9, Monday: Full Day of Retreat in Lourdes

Breakfast at our hotel. **Mass at the Grotto** (To be confirmed. Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.) Independent lunch and free day for private devotions. **Baths are open 8:30 am - 12:30 pm / 1:30 pm - 6:00 pm on weekdays. The Blessed Sacrament procession is held daily at 5:00 pm. During the procession there are meditations, prayers, hymns and chants, in several languages. When all the participants have assembled, there follows a period of Eucharistic Adoration, and the Blessing of the Sick. The Chapel of Reconciliation is open daily. After dinner, join in the Torchlight Marian procession, praying the Rosary and singing hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 10 July 10, Tuesday: Lourdes | Paris | USA

After early breakfast, you will be transfer to Pau Airport for our return flight to New York via Paris. This afternoon arrive at JFK International Airport filled to overflowing with memories that will change your life. (B)

Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. The package pricing reflects a discount of \$100.00 per person for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. The package price is \$100 higher if paid by credit card. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Tentative round trip from New York JFK International Airport on Air France-KLM-Delta Alliance (to be confirmed August 15, 2017). Flight itinerary and carrier are subject to changes. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**Estimated \$2,880.00, to be confirmed August 15, 2017**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are usually not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking for an additional charge of \$695.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager/guide, and driver are not included in the package price and will be collected prior to departure. **\$100.00 will be added to each participant's final invoice to cover tips for the 10-Day Pilgrimage.** Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for the maid or housekeeper.
