Dear families and friends of the EEPS community,

#### **Class Placement Process - Information for Parents**

Like every school around the State, EEPS is now beginning the process of forming new classes for 2017. At this stage we are still not sure of our final enrolment so we cannot give you exact classes or which teacher will be teaching which year level. As teachers will soon be commencing the task of allocating students to classes we would like you to know the process we follow when making these decisions.

Prior to allocating students to classes, class teachers give students the opportunity to record five students from their year level who they would like to be with next year. Teachers encourage students to think

beyond their own class and to name students with whom they work well, rather than just their friends. It is **not a priority** listing so that it doesn't matter which name is written first. A **"students I work well with"** page is attached to the newsletter and a hard copy will go home with your child today. You and your child will have the opportunity to name 5 children they would like to have in their class. Class teachers explain that **at least one** of those named will be in their class for the following year.

The teachers follow a strict process when allocating students in priority order:

- There is an equal distribution of academic, social and emotional needs.
  - There is an equal distribution (as far as possible) of boys and girls.
  - Each student is placed with at least one of their five (5) named friends from their year level.
  - There is an equal distribution of students with challenging behaviours.
  - At times teachers believe some students would benefit from being separated.

We will make the classes as balanced as we can. We do not accept requests regarding teachers. In the past this has got out of hand and caused many problems in classes which were not balanced as some teachers were perceived as having a special gift in a particular area. Please trust us; we know your children and their learning styles.
