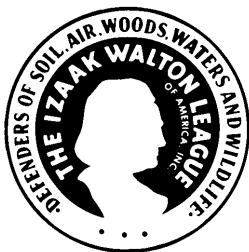

The Izaak Walton Pledge

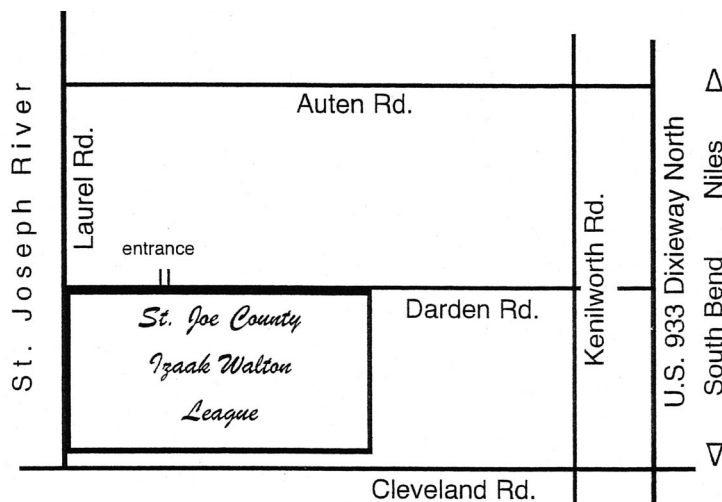

The entrance to the grounds is near the corner of Laurel and Darden roads in South Bend, Indiana. The property is comprised of 120 acres, most of which is wooded with a diverse variety of native trees and plants. In addition to woods and meadows, there are hiking trails, picnic areas, wetlands, natural springs, three ponds and both banks of the Saint. Joseph River. Indoor and outdoor archery are offered along with a world class roving range. Aside from diverse and unique physical attributes, IWL enjoys a membership rich in talents and skills, enabling itself to become a major force in conservation issues.
