- Assist in the preparation of jobsites prior to the beginning of a project
- Supervise, coordinate, and schedule the day to day work activities of a landscape construction crew of 2-3 employees
- Delegate job tasks to appropriate crew members to assist in the completion of landscape constructions
- Operate various tools and equipment, including: heavy equipment, chainsaws, jackhammers, laser levels, measurement equipment, shovels, hammers, drills, etc.
- Supervise site preparation, establishing grade/elevations, excavation, installation of paver patios, walkways, and retaining walls, water gardens, landscape lighting, and lawn install, and mulching
- General skill and knowledge of all landscape plants and plant install procedures
- Be able to perform some general bed maintenance
- Perform preventative maintenance on tools and equipment by conducting inspections, lubricating, and cleaning
- Read and interpret blueprints, structural drawings, and specifications to delegate/complete work activities

- Be able to coordinate with subcontractors and supervise quality, efficiency, and deadlines
- Complete and submit all required paperwork on a daily basis
- Comply with all company policies and regulations
- Maintain and enforce standards of cleanliness and organization in trucks, trailers, equipment, jobsites, shop/yard areas
