

An international survey on children born of war

A comparative study on Danish, Norwegian and Dutch war children

Abstract

The survey was carried out among 650 members of the Norwegian war child association (NKBF) in 1997 and about 400 members of the Danish war child association (DKBF) in 2003. In addition, about 50 Dutch war children participated in the survey. The survey includes 250 questions, both standardised and open-ended questions. The questionnaire covers topics such as social structure, health, places of living, childhood and adolescence, identity, questions about biological mother and father, own family, social integration and identity as a war child.
