Lenox Hill Neighborhood House RealArts Summer Camp is a dynamic summer program for children ages 5 to 12 with an emphasis on arts education, aquatics and recreation. Led by experienced teaching artists and trained teachers, our campers enjoy a diverse array of dance, drama, music, visual art and swimming classes.

Additional activities include indoor and outdoor recreation, weekly field trips throughout Manhattan, participation in performances on Lenox Hill Neighborhood House’s main stage and farm-to-table nutritious meals (breakfast, lunch and snack) prepared by our in-house Food Services team.

SPECIALTY CAMPS

Art Explorers (for children ages 5 – 6, Kindergarten and 1st grade)

Art Explorers learn fundamental techniques in dance, drama, music, visual art and swimming. Campers participate in outdoor and indoor recreational activities, fun cultural projects, live performance experiences and weekly local field trips. Explorers will also participate in the RealArts final showcase at the end of each session. Our approach is to introduce our youngest campers to a variety of creative expressions and foster their explorative journey as blossoming artists.

Art Adventurers A and B groups (for children ages 6 – 9, entering 2nd, 3rd and 4th grades)

Art Adventure campers build upon their foundational skills in dance, drama, music and visual arts. Campers focus on both process and product based art forms and techniques. Each camp session will culminate in an original theater production and art exhibit. Additional activities will include swim instruction, exciting weekly field trips to local destinations and live performances. Groups will also participate in fun sports-based recreational activities and cultural projects. The curriculum for these groups focuses on building confidence in each child as emerging artists and encourages campers to take creative risks as they work collaboratively with their peers.

Art Wizards (for children ages 10 – 12, entering 5th, 6th and 7th grades)

Our Art Wizards will explore a more advanced artistic process and product creation in both visual and performing arts, and will perform an original theater production in each session's final showcase. Art activities will be balanced with plenty of time for indoor and outdoor sports and recreation, including, soccer, basketball, kickball and teambuilding group games. Additional activities will include swim instruction and exciting weekly field trips to NYC destinations and live performances. Art Wizards offers a perfect combination for campers who are enthusiastic about participating in both arts and sports/recreation activities.

Musical Theater Camp (for children ages 10 – 12, entering 5th, 6th and 7th grades)

Musical Theater camp is designed for campers with previous experience in performing arts and/or an interest in theater and production design. Campers work in a collaborative setting to develop and perform an original musical theater piece that will incorporate dance, music, set and costume design in an ensemble environment, and will be performed at the end of each session. Campers can choose a performance-focused track or a design production-focused track, but all campers are encouraged to participate in the final showcase. Additional activities will include swim instruction, group games and sports-based recreational activities, and exciting weekly field trips to NYC destinations and live performances.
