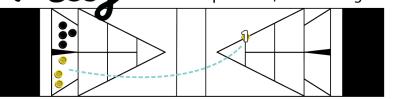
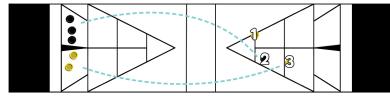
Royal PALMS SHUFFLEBOARD the kitchen shooting areas (-10 pts) dead zone

L Two teams per court, each team gets four biscuits

DO NOT WALK ON THE COURTS. (No, seriously, don't do it)



The Yellow Team starts the game by sending a biscuit down to the scoring triangle at the other end of the court.



Then Black and Yellow alternate until all 8 biscuits have been played. This is one "frame". A full match is 8 frames.

HEY, Teammates at the far end, in addition to letting your partner know which discs are scoring, when a biscuit lands in the Dead Zone, pull it out of play, will ya?

Pro tip: Always use the TIP of your tang to slide biscuits. The only time the CLAW should touch the ground is to shoot.

tangs

This is the tang

Technique:

- 1. Keep your biscuit on your side of the shooting triangle.
- 2. Relax your arm straight at your side and let the tang hang loosely in ONE hand.
- 3. Take two small steps forward and use the momentum to thrust your biscuit to victory!
- 4. Trash Talk optional, but recommended.

NOBODY LIKES A BISCUIT BANGER

Make sure the claw end of your tang is cradling your disc when you shoot

Little, and any disk that lands, * YOUCH AMY Time. Not even a Aitchen is worth 10 8 claw

At the end of each frame, count up the points of the scoring discs are left in the triangle.

Feel free to ask our staff if you need a second opinion. Write each team's points on the scoreboard (here Yellow is

7 and Black is 8), adding to the last frame's score as you go. Whoever has the most points at the end of 8 frames WINS.

Always celebrate horizontally, not vertically. Ceiling fans and tangs don't mix.
