THREE SIZES:

26-27 inch Chest	-	10 ozs.
28-29 inch Chest	-	12 ozs.
30-31 inch Chest	-	14 ozs.

Double Knitting

POLO JUMPER

(in 3 sizes)

INSTRUCTIONS are given for a 26-27 inch chest. Changes for a 28-29 and 30-31 inch chest are given in brackets.

Materials: 10 (12 : 14) ozs. of HAYFIELD DOUBLE KNITTING WOOL, 1 pair of No. 7 knitting needles and 1 set of 4 double pointed No. 9 knitting needles.

Measurements: To fit a 26-27 (28-29 : 30-31) inch chest. Length from shoulder $15\frac{1}{2}$ (17 : $18\frac{1}{2}$) inches. Sleeve seam $12\frac{1}{2}$ (14 : $15\frac{1}{2}$) inches.

Tension: Approx. 6 stitches to 1 inch.

Abbreviations: K. = knit; P. = purl; st(s). = stitch(es); inc. = increase; dec. = decrease; beg. = beginning; rep. = repeat; patt. = pattern.

Note: Always cast on with the thumb method.

WORK BACK AND FRONT

ALIKE

Using two No. 9 needles cast on 74 (80 : 86) sts. Work $2\frac{1}{4}$ ($2\frac{1}{2}$: $2\frac{3}{4}$) inches in K.1, P.1 rib, inc. in every 10th (12th : 17th) stitch of last row — 81 (86 : 91) sts.

Change to No. 7 needles and the following pattern:

1st row.—Knit.

2nd row.—* P.1, K.4, rep. from * to last stitch, P.1.

Rep. rows 1 and 2 twice more.

7th row.—Knit.

8th row.—Purl.

9th row.—Knit.

10th row.—Purl.

These 10 rows form the patt.

Work until 10 (11 : 12) inches from beg.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows, then dec. at both ends of every row until 61 (66 : 71) sts. remain.

Work $3\frac{1}{4}$ ($3\frac{1}{2}$: $3\frac{3}{4}$) inches.

Shape Neck

Work 26 (28 : 30) sts., cast off 9 (10 : 11) sts., work to end. Continue on the last set of stitches for $1\frac{1}{4}$ ($1\frac{1}{2}$: $1\frac{3}{4}$) inches, at the same time dec. once in every row at the neck edge until 19 (21 : 23) sts. remain.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 7 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 armhole end rows.

Work one more row. Cast off remainder.

Rejoin the wool at the neck edge to the first set of stitches. Work $1\frac{1}{4}$ ($1\frac{1}{2}$: $1\frac{3}{4}$) inches at the same time dec. once

in every row at the neck edge until 19 (21 : 23) sts. remain.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 7 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 armhole end rows.

Work one more row. Cast off remainder.

THE SLEEVES

Using two No. 9 needles cast on 36 (40 : 46) sts.

Work $1\frac{1}{2}$ (2 : $2\frac{1}{2}$) inches in K.1, P.1 rib, inc. once at end of last row for size 28-29 only — 36 (41 : 46) sts. Change to No. 7 needles. Work one pattern, then inc. at both ends of the 1st and 7th rows of every pattern following until 56 (61 : 66) sts. on the needle.

Continue without further shaping

until $12\frac{1}{2}$ (14 : $15\frac{1}{2}$) inches from beg. [or length required].

Shape Top

Dec. at both ends of every row until 12 (13 : 14) sts. remain. Cast off.

THE COLLAR

Sew the shoulder seams. Use four No. 9 needles. Pick up and knit 92 (98 : 104) sts. round the neck edge. Arrange on 3 needles and with 4th needle work in rounds of K.1, P.1 rib for 4 ($4\frac{1}{2}$: 5) inches. Cast off loosely and in the rib.

TO MAKE UP

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Press on wrong side, using a hot iron over a damp cloth. Roll over collar.
