**Pray as the Spirit leads** – Spirit lead our hearts this day for whatever you would have us to pray. Even when we don't have words we know that you intercede for us. Stir our hearts for the lostness in this city.

**Confession/Repentance** – Ask the Lord to search you (Pslam 139: 23-24) and show you any offensive way to Him. Take the time to listen. Repent of any unforgiveness or unconfessed sin. May it be brought into the light by true confession and repentance so that we may have open and clear communication with the Father.

**Top 5** – Pray for five people that either don't know Jesus or are far from God. Pray the Father gives them eyes to see and ears to hear. Pray for good soil in their hearts.

**Hearts of Thanksgiving** – May we enter into His courts with praise and thanksgiving in all that we do as the Church in Galveston. May the Body of Christ be the most joy filled people in the community! We give you praise Jesus! May your Name be lifted high above this city as a banner!

**Intimacy with the Father** – Pray that our hearts would align with the Father's heart as we spend time with Him. That we would truly abide in Him. We would actually know the Father and not just know about Him.

**Awareness** – Pray that the Father would give us eyes to see the things he sees. Let us move about strategically, but doing so as Jesus instructed the disciples; innocent as doves and wise as serpents.

### **Galveston Churches**

Please pray for the churches on the island. There are some numbers that estimate over 50 on the island. Take a look at **John 17** and how Jesus prayed for unity. Pray that we "may be one...may we be one, may we be one until we reach complete unity." It's all for His glory and His Kingdom. Pray for the Lord's vision for Galveston island. **Pray for Pastors-** Pray the pastors would be able to humble themselves for the sake of the Kingdom and to reach every person on this island for Jesus. Pray for their protection as well as their families. Pray the Lord continue to give them strength and revelation in their ministry. **The 50,000** – it is said there are around 50,000 people here in Galveston and around 5000 believers or churchgoers. Pray the Holy Spirit begin interacting with their hearts, and Lord make us aware of opportunities to love people. The disciples turned the world upside down with a small group...can you imagine how 5000 can impact the 45,000 who don't know Christ?

**PHC** – Pray for the new Pregnancy Help Center that will be setting foot on the ground very soon on the island to minister to the needs of the community. Pray for those involved for a furthered vision of what this looks like in Galveston. Pray for those involved from the Lake Jackson PHC who will be helping to launch the effort here.

**Christ Together Galveston** – this is a unified effort in the name of Jesus to reach every man, woman and child with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Please pray that something would stir deep in every church as we come together in unity through prayer, worship, service and fellowship. Pray for humble hearts and pride to be left at the door. Pray what Jesus prayed in John 17...complete unity to reach those who don't know Jesus. We are praying that Galveston would become an island of God.

**City of Galveston** – Pray for a growing and working relationship between the churches and government on the island. True transformation on multiple levels will occur by the Church stepping up. Pray for connections to be made. Pray the city would be prosperous and all for the glory of the Lord. We pray for crime rates, divorce rates, abuse, and hate to all decrease. We pray for our school system to be transformed into one of the best in the country.

**Tipping Point/Spill Over** – God is looking for cities that would be completely His. He's looking for places in which breakthrough will occur that will affect every realm of society. Cities in which "on earth as it is in heaven is truly lived out." This will create a domino effect in which city after city will be brought into the Kingdom.

**House of Prayer** – in the fall there will be a family moving to the island to establish a House of Prayer; Reflection Center Galveston. We want to lift up the Adam's family as they make their transition to Galveston. Imagine an island/city in which there is someone or group praising and worshiping the King 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
