



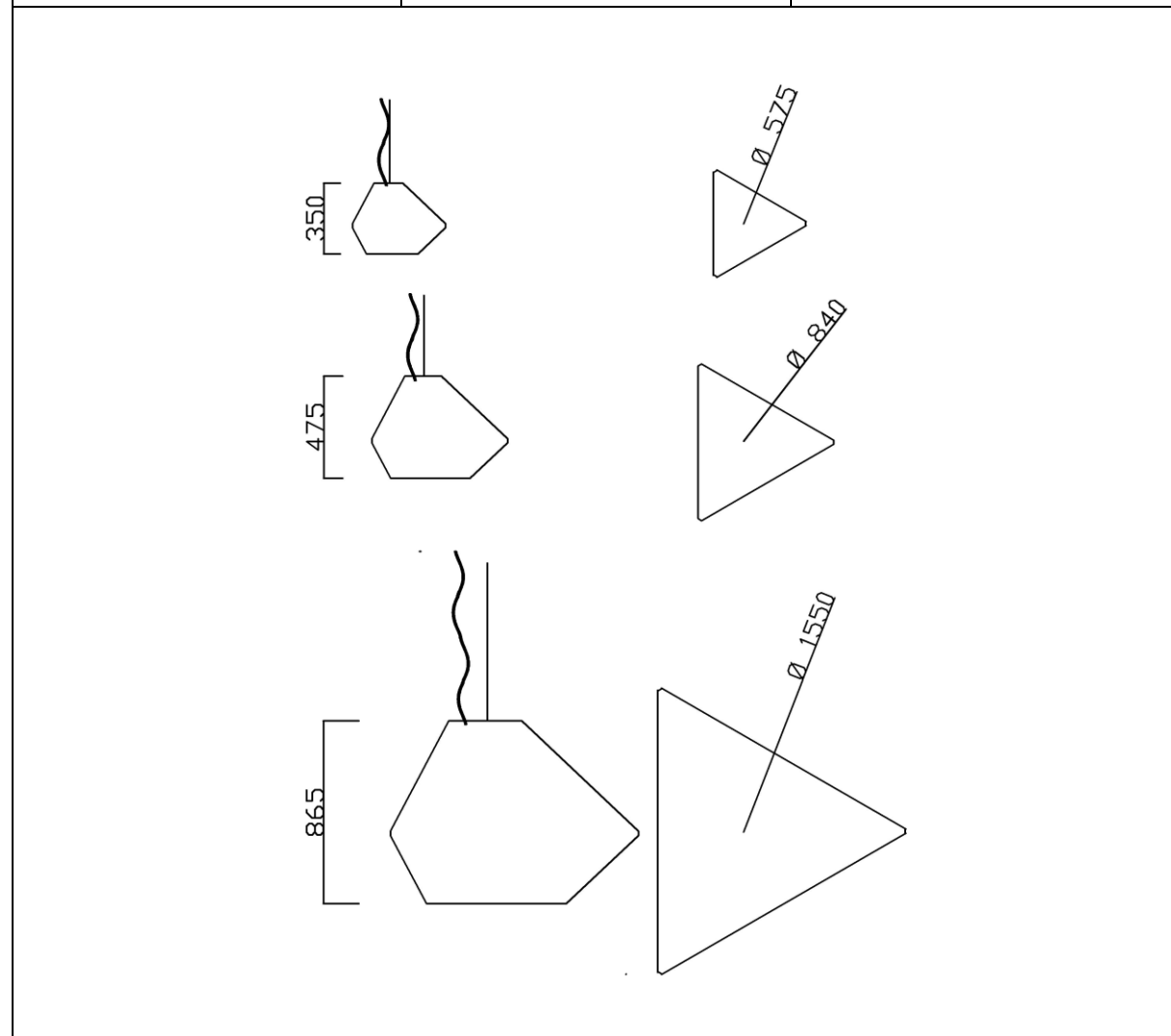

## General Maintenance Recommendations

| <p>Luminaires should normally be cleaned in connection with relamping.<br/>Reflective surfaces ought to be cleaned if / when dust or grime is discovered.</p> <p><u>Always</u> disconnect the voltage before cleaning, make sure electrical components and cabling is <i>not exposed to cleaning agent or water</i>.</p> <p>Use clean antistatic gloves when handling parts that are to be cleaned.<br/>Unpowdered latex gloves to be used during washing.<br/>Wash using a clean cloth, without microfiber or cotton.<br/>Make sure to often change water and cloths.<br/>For high reflective materials, use cleaning leather / compressed air where applicable.<br/>Drying spots might occur when self drying.</p> <p>In general, indoor luminaires are to be cleaned after 2-3 years. Outdoor luminaires after 5 year.<br/>Contact manufacturer if uncertain.</p> <p>Recommended cleaning / material in regards of pollution, see below.</p> |

## Installation Sound Macro / Medi / Mini

1. Make sure that the voltage and frequency of the mains corresponds with the luminaire.
2. Attach the ceiling attachment.
3. Connect mains to ceiling attachment.
4. Adjust height of the luminaire with the attachment, cutting of excessive wire.
5. Connect canopy to ceiling attachment.

To replace LED-module, contact manufacturer.
