2019 Vital Rosé

100% Mourvedre donated by Seven Hills Vineyard, Walla Walla Valley AVA

Aromas are initially clean, crisp, and tight with light floral, candy ester, cucumber, and red fruits. Fruit intensity grows with hibiscus and lime on the palate. The wine is structured by firm acidity and some phenolic complexity, finishing crisp with lingering impressions of peppery spice and herb. Pairs well with the first spring and summer salads and a wide range of grilled foods.

The 2019 Rose was made for Vital by the staff of Artifex Wine Company and Tim Doyle, winemaker/owner of Marginalia Winery in Walla Walla.

- Picked at 19 brix
- Hand harvested by the crew at Seven Hills Vineyard on September 17, 2019
- Crushed and cold-macerated under inert gas for 8 hours before pressing
- Fermented and aged in neutral oak barrels for 4 months with occasional stirring
- 11.2% alcohol, with zero residual sugar
- Finished at 3.22 pH and 6 g/L titratable acidity; no malolactic conversion
- 104 cases 750 ml bottles and 6 cases 1.5 liter magnums produced
