Dear Ms. Handrahan:

This letter is an interim response to your June 28, 2015, Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act request that was received in the Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office of the General Counsel, on June 29, 2015, for processing and responding directly to you. A copy of your request is attached for your convenience.

Please be advised that a search has been conducted in OJP and enclosed is a one-page document that responds to your questions. Also, enclosed are nine pages of material in response to question #4 of your request. These documents are appropriate for release in full and without excisions. Additional documents will be sent in response to question #1 as soon as they are received and processed by this office.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

1. Please be advised that documents will be sent as soon as they are received and processed by this office pursuant to FOIA.
2. The funding levels are located at: <http://www.ojjdp.gov/funding/funding.html>. They are listed under the title of "Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited" or "Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuations"
3. The arrests that were provided were for each calendar year.
4. See attached chart for the 2014 arrests totals. Please note that these are totals and not rates
5. None have been completed at this time. Frequent contact is made between the ICAC commanders and the OJJDP program managers – including face-to-face meeting three times a year. There are no formal evaluation or assessments.
6. Sec 106 of the PROTECT Our Children Act of 2008 requires that each ICAC task force receive a minimum amount of the available funding and then use a funding formula to distribute the remaining ICAC dollars. OJJDP determined that each task force should receive a minimum of 1% of the available funding (\$220,000 minimum in FY 2014) and then have the remaining dollars distributed via a formula. The variables included in the formula are:
 - Registered Sex Offenders
 - Peer-2-Peer Data
 - CyberTip Referrals (generated by the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children) to ICAC Task Forces
 - Jurisdictional Population
 - Cases Referred for Federal Prosecution
 - Technical Assists (Technical Support) provided by the Task Force
 - Training Sessions Provided
 - Community Outreach Presentations

As a result of the above, ICAC Task Forces that are not performing at a high level will in fact see their funding levels decrease.

7. At this time, OJJDP does not plan to require the ICAC task forces to collect and/or report on arrest demographics. However, if a task force should choose to do so, OJJDP would not object.

Dear Ms. Lee;

Per Jeffrey Gersh's instructions, under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I am officially submitting another FOIA request to the OJJDP at DOJ.

We have just launched Data4Justice <http://www.data4justice.org> an attempt to crowd-source data on child porn arrests in America. Gratitude to OJJDP Director Robert Listenbee for answering my FOIA on ICAC data <http://data4justice.org/about/>

Since we posted this data we have more questions on missing pieces of data. Could DOJ please provide the following information:

1. In the response to my last FOIA, DOJ says that each ICAC Taskforce is required to submit prosecution rates correlated to the arrest rates. In other words if Polk County Florida has 2,000 arrests but of those 2,000 arrests only 100 are successfully prosecuted that is a very important piece of information.

Please provide the reported ICAC Taskforce prosecution rates, per ICAC Taskforce from 2009 until the most recent year possible.

2. In the response to my last FOIA, DOJ provided a link to the funding levels provided by DOJ to each ICAC Taskforce; however, the information available on that link appeared to be only for FY 2010-2011.

Please provide the funding provided by OJJDP DOJ to each ICAC Taskforce from FY 2009 through the most recent year possible.

3. In the response to my last FOIA, DOJ a very helpful (thank you) chart of reported ICAC arrests from 2009 – 2013.

Please confirm, were these arrests were reported per calendar year or per fiscal year?

4. If arrest rates are available for 2014 please provide these.
5. If any evaluations or assessments of each ICAC Taskforce have been completed, please provide these.
6. Now that data4justice.org has published the results of the ICAC data from the first FOIA request, what action will OJJDP take regarding this information?

Will ICAC Taskforces that are performing exceptionally well (like Florida) be rewarded, recognized, and provided more funding?

Will ICAC Taskforces that are performing exceptionally poorly (like Maine) be investigated?

Will poor performers be asked why their arrest rates are so low and what they are doing with their OJJDP DOJ funding?

Will poor performers receive less funding until their performance improves?

7. For the remainder of 2015 and 2016, will OJJDP request that ICAC Taskforces begin to collect and report on, both to DOJ and make public on their own ICAC Taskforce websites, demographics on their child porn arrests? And if so, which demographics will be required?
