APPLICATION FEE

An **application fee of \$150** is payable for each student. This is a one off application fee per enrolment and is non-refundable.

SERVICE FEE

The service fee covers costs such as annual levies to Association of Independent Schools (AISSA), copyright and photocopying fees, IT software licencing costs, ID cards and student insurance.

The service fee is standard for all students, irrespective of study load.

TAX DEDUCTIBLE BUILDING FUND

The College's Building Fund finances the continuing refurbishment and improvement of existing buildings and resources.

The suggested voluntary contribution is \$150 per family per term. You are welcome to nominate an alternative amount. **Building Fund contributions are tax deductible** and non-refundable.

PART-TIME or OVERLOAD

Year 12 students beyond the age of compulsion (revised in 2009 to 17 years of age) may enrol as part-time students – in these cases the tuition fees will be adjusted accordingly.

Students studying the maximum number of subjects for their year level or one subject below are considered full-time students. Students studying less than this are considered part-time students.

Any student studying more or less than a full time load may have their fees increased or decreased accordingly.

EYNESBURY SENIOR COLLEGE – 2017 FEE SCHEDULE

Tuitions fees and charges are billed in 4 instalments and issued in January, April, June and September. Accounts are due for payment within 21 days of the date of issue; unless an instalment arrangement has been approved by the Business Manager.

SIBLING REBATE

The following discount on tuition fees applies to families with more than one child attending the school. Enrolments do not need to be concurrent to attract the discount.

Second child rebate	10%
Third child rebate	20%
Fourth child rebate	30%
Fifth child rebate	40% (maximum rebate available)

SCHOLARSHIPS & REMISSIONS

All scholarship applicants must apply to the selection process – two scholarship application times are offered each year: April and September.

To apply please contact the College or see the published dates on the website.

Scholarship remissions apply to the tuition component of fees only.

A non-refundable scholarship application fee of \$150 is payable when submitting the scholarship application form.

Bursaries are also available for Homestay or Boarding students (Tuition fees only). If a Homestay or Boarding student also applies for a scholarship then, if successful, the application fee will be credited to the student's account.

EARLY PAYMENT DISCOUNT

An early settlement discount of **4% applies to the net tuition fees component** if the year's fees are paid in full on or before the 27th January 2017.

Please note that the discount applies to the net tuition fee only, and not the service fee. Discount is calculated on the net value of tuition fees less any sibling, scholarship and bursary discount (where applicable).

No discount applies to credit card payments.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP REMISSION (OLD SCHOOL CARD REBATE)

From 2014, the State Government ceased to provide funding to Non-Government Schools for School Card eligible students. However, Eynesbury Senior College continues to offer a 25% remission to students who are deemed to be eligible for School Card by DECD.

The College offers a **25% rebate on tuition fees only** for students that are declared eligible for School Card by DECD. Eligibility is based on State Government financial criteria and it is the family's responsibility to apply for School Card assistance at the start of each year.

Please submit the School Card Application Form for 2017 by the end of Term 1. Families that were awarded School Card Discount in 2016, can continue to claim the rebate in 2017 provided their ongoing eligibility is confirmed by DECD. If a family is assessed as ineligible for 2017 and therefore removed from the school card list provided by DECD, the remission will be added back onto the family account and the amount payable increased accordingly.

EYNESBURY SENIOR COLLEGE – 2017 FEE SCHEDULE

New families to the College that have not previously been declared eligible must wait for the decision regarding their eligibility from DECD, before the discount can be applied to their family account. Once successful, the financial hardship remission credit will be applied to the family debtor account and the amount payable will be decreased accordingly.

Families that are entitled to a Sibling Rebate will receive the higher of the Financial Hardship Remission or the Sibling Rebate, but not both.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Fees must be paid on time so that the College can meet its financial commitments. Families who may be experiencing difficulties in meeting payments are urged to contact the Executive Assistant to the Principal as soon as possible to discuss payment options.

All fees, regardless of method of payment, must be paid in full by **13 October 2017**.

Late Payments: Instalments not paid by the due date(s) may result in a \$75 late payment fee being charged.

Eynesbury Senior College reserves the right to institute collection proceedings to collect overdue fees, and the cost of this collection will be added to your account and payable by you.

Eynesbury Senior College reserves the right to terminate the schooling of a student whose fees are in arrears.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

OPTION 1 Year in Advance (an early payment discount applies) – due on or before 27 January 2017.

Please contact the **EA to the Principal on 8216 9149** for your revised payment amount as calculations will vary for each student.

OPTION 2 Payment in 4 instalments – in accordance with due dates on the invoice.

OPTION 3 Payment Plan - regular direct debit or credit card instalments, by arrangement with the finance office.

All Payment Plans must be paid in full by **13 October 2017**.

This option incurs a **\$220 administration fee** which is payable with the first instalment. Late payment fees may be charged if instalments are not received in accordance with the agreed schedule.

Direct debit & credit card instalments will be processed on the date indicated on the agreed instalment schedule. It is your responsibility to ensure that there are sufficient funds available in accordance with your instalment agreement.

HOW TO PAY

IN PERSON Payment can be made in person at the College, 15-19 Franklin St Adelaide. Cheques, money orders, credit cards and EFT are accepted.

Cash up to a maximum of \$500 can be accepted over the counter. Cash amounts over \$500 must be paid directly into our bank account (details below).

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENT

In accordance with the terms of enrolment (“ESC Application for Enrolment” signed at the time of accepting a position at Eynesbury Senior College) Parents/Carers acknowledge that they are required to give the College one term’s written notice of withdrawal of a student.

Notice of withdrawal of a student must be given in writing to the Principal. Verbal notification or notification to a staff member other than the Principal is not considered due notice. Failure to provide the required notice will result in a pro-rata charge of the annual tuition fees and charges equating to one quarter of the tuition fees and charges.
