

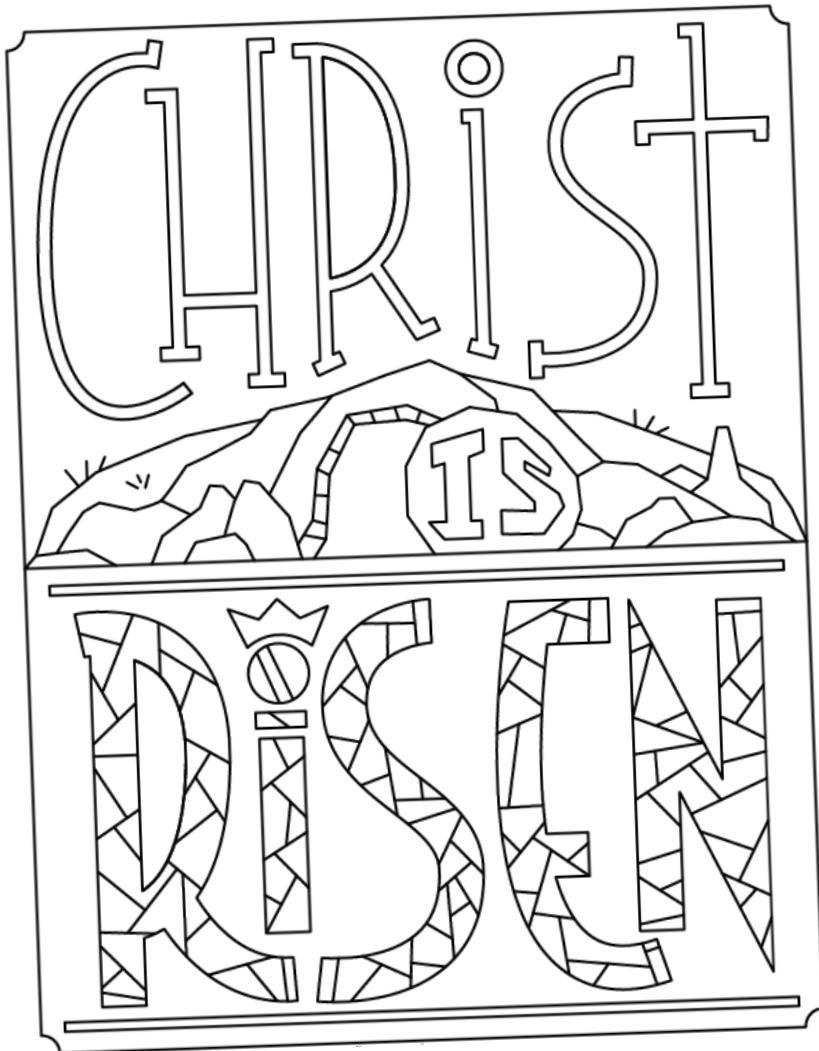
# resurrection hope
