ON MAY 16TH, CELEBRATE OUR 10TH ANNUAL BREAKFAST WITH HEATHER MOYSE!

Describing this two-time Olympic Gold Medalist in one phrase is a difficult task: multi-sport national athlete (bobsleigh, rugby, and track cycling), inspirational speaker, ambassador, humanitarian,

and above all, champion and leader. She is a 3-time Olympian and 2-time Olympic gold medalist, and lives by her personal motto, "Believe in the possibilities." From the small PEI town of Summerside to the top of the Olympic podium, Heather has been described as Canada's best ever all-round female athlete. Heather first captured the nation's attention in 2010 after winning Canada's first ever Women's Bobsleigh Olympic gold medal with teammate Kaillie Humphries in Whistler, BC. Heather was also the leading try-scorer in both the 2006 and 2010 Women's Rugby World Cups, and was selected as one of only two females in the world to be International Rugby Anti-doping Ambassadors. As a lifelong humanitarian and proud islander, Heather donates her time and talent to many national charities, earning her the Order of PEI – the highest honour to be bestowed in any province in Canada.

To pay by cheque, fill in a Pinehurst Club™ form and mail to The Pinehurst Club™, 28 Pinehurst Cres, Toronto, ON, M9A 3A5, and receive your charitable receipt via mail about 2 months after the breakfast. You may also give or send your cheque to an Ambassador.

If you attend the breakfast, your charitable receipt will be for about 75% of the paid amount, as Revenue Canada requires the cost of each breakfast to be deducted. If you do not attend the breakfast and make a donation, you will receive a charitable receipt for 100% of your donation.
