

Bluffton Boiled Peanut Festival 2017

Vendors will be able to sell their goods during the event on September 10th. All vendors should be set up by 11am the day of the event. Please look over the safety guidelines attached. Peanut Vendor Booths are for those selling peanut-related foods such as artisan boiled peanuts, peanut baked goods, etc.

FOOD VENDOR INFORMATION

- Alcoholic Beverages are **NOT** permitted for sale by any vendors of the Boiled Peanut Festival. However you may sell non-alcoholic beverages such as Water, Tea, Lemonade etc
- **You will also need a Certified Fire Extinguisher at your booth: (2A10BC)**
- **Trash:** ALL vendors will be responsible for their own trash removal. Please provide a trash can at your booth space for disposing of your food trash and leaving your space clean. Trash containers will be available on site for attendees of the event for disposables only; i.e. paper plates, napkins cups. Dumping vendor trash in this receptacles is strictly prohibited.
- If you are using cooking oil or Charcoal, you will be responsible for its proper removal. It is not to be placed in the dumpster or dumped on site.
- You are responsible for providing your own tent, table(chairs), and decorations. We are providing space for your booth only. If your booth requires electricity – you will be required to provide your own.

Hold Harmless Agreement

The undersigned agrees that he/she will be responsible for any loss or damages to his/her merchandise or for personal injury during the course of The Boiled Peanut Festival.

It is further agreed that the undersigned will abide by all rules as set forth by the The Boiled Peanut Festival & the Greater Bluffton Chamber of Commerce will hold harmless and release The Boiled Peanut Festival & the Greater Bluffton Chamber of Commerce from any civil liability hereunder regardless of the nature, cause, or extent thereof.
