2.0	<p>Update on current status of residency program (All)</p> <p><u>Current residents:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -resident progress <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 14 residents progressing through the program -Residency Presentation Night 19MAY10, project progress <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • usual amount of project panic at this point. None in serious jeopardy. -Oral Assessments - Mar'10 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AJ reports residents are nervous but no specific recommendations for additional help at this point. -AHD update (ML) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • several present have facilitated resident-led therapeutics workshops and all expressed that they work very well. 3.0	<p>Strategic Plans & Activities (All)</p> <p>LMPS integration plans, residency implications.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is assumed that we're heading toward a single LMPS residency program and possibly an altered relationship with UBC for experiential learning. The group was encouraged to envision the best possible future and advocate and plan for it. RE provided reasons for concern about sustainability of residency training if an external body makes the funding decisions.

	<p>40 years of residency training: VGH, SPH, LGH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2010 marks the 40th anniversary of residency training beginning at VGH and SPH (1970), and LGH started in 1971.• Residency program website will receive badging recognizing this, alerts to staff• Suggestion: organize some sort of recognition event (possibly around CSHP SES 2011 in August in Vancouver) to recognize showcase past graduates, innovations and programs over the years which stemmed from residency projects. Contact past grads across Canada. <p>DD rotations for prior Gr1 pharmacists.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For 2010-11 cycle, the two residents with prior Gr1 pharmacist experience will do a DPC rotation instead of a DD rotation. PL has notified and received feedback from the DD rotation coordinators about this, and they're supportive, with consideration for some sort of altered DD rotation such people to be investigated for following cycle. Everyone reinforced that regardless of the formal structure of the DD rotation, it should always be tailored (as with all rotations) to residents' prior knowledge/experience.• PL is having both prior-Gr1 residents do a self-assessment of the relevant CHPRB 2010 standards so their standing in regards to them can be assessed/documentated.• ZK reminded the group that we should have a written policy re: how we account for and give credit for prior learning. PL will develop and post on the residency site. <p>Med Safety learning for 2010-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For 2010-11 the MedSafety rotation is deleted and the content will be distributed into the AHD program.• Suggestion: Create a new rotation much like the MUM rotation (but, say, 1 week) where residents integrate with the work MedSaf pharmacists are doing around the region. All supported this, and PL will work with Fruzsina Pataky on it for next year.
