Role Description:

Intern - as a general Nature in the City intern you will be able to get involved with different projects and build many career skills. Due to NTC having ongoing projects in different parts of the city our intern will have to be mobile and flexible.

- the intern position is expected to attend volunteer work days (generally once a month on a weekend) and provide Staff and Site stewards with organizational and supervisory support
- You are expected to take initiative on projects that attract your attention and will be given the proper mentoring and training
