The stadium is a part of local team history and has been the home to the Raiders and the 49ers. Now the stadium is home to San Francisco's professional soccer team, the Deltas. The community garden is also a treasure of the community and is home to raised beds, bees, native plants for give away and everything else a garden can provide. As two unique parts of the panhandle of golden gate park, the stadium and garden enhance the local ecology of the area and provide great spaces for nature and sport enthusiasts alike.
