Relocation of a Metal Spinning Production Facility

This family owned company of 16 employees was growing and needed a larger facility to keep up with customer demand for their metal spinning products. The company located a 29,000 SF building in Oak Creek allowing for 10,000 additional square feet of expansion in an improved facility.
