In May 2015, the American Indian Movement Interpretive Center was awarded a Minnesota Historical and Cultural Heritage grant from the Minnesota Historical Society to support the planning and of an exhibit that details the history and beneficial effects of the American Indian Movement in Minnesota, the United States and the world.
