6th Grade Intro to World History *1 credit*

This course focuses on the historical, cultural, and political perspectives of various world societies from ancient to early modern times. It engages the students in using the tools and methods of various social scientists to inquire and examine diversity, commonalities, dynamics, and interactions of cultures past and contemporary.

6th Grade Intro to World History Honors *1 credit*

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7th Grade Geography *1 credit*

7th Grade Geography Honors *1 credit*
