Nov. 6 - Depart USA

Today you will depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

Nov. 7 - Arrive Tel Aviv

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and enjoy a drive through Biblical Joppa, now the port city of Jaffa before being transferred to your Netanya hotel for check-in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

Nov. 8 - From Sea to Sea

Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Cana (Drive Through), Nazareth, Magdala

After a delicious buffet breakfast, travel to **Caesarea by the Sea** on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 & 26). Look across the Valley of Jezreel to the heights of **Mount Carmel**. On this mount, Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo** where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Recall Jesus' first miracle as you pass through **Cana** (John 2). View the city of **Nazareth** from the **Mount of Precipice** vantage point where tradition states the local populace attempted to throw the Lord off a cliff. Your final stop will be the ruins of **Magdala**, home town of Mary of Magdala on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Continue to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 9 - Jesus in the Galilee

Boat Ride, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Chapel of the Primacy, Jordan River

Enjoy a boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee** and appreciate the special place this lake had in Jesus' ministry. Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue that stands on the site where Jesus taught. Visit the peaceful **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7). Stop at **Tabgha**, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the **Church of the Loaves and Fish** (Luke 9). Also stop at the **Chapel of the Primacy**, where Peter confessed his devotion to Christ 3 times (John 21). End the day together at the **Jordan River** where you can remember or renew your baptism.

Nov. 10 - Northern Israel

Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Golan Heights

Journey north to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). You will also visit the ancient remains of **Tel Dan** and the altar built by King Jeroboam I (1 Kings 12:25-30). Travel through the **Golan Heights** and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel.

Nov. 11 - South Along the Jordan

Beit Shean, Jordan Valley, Qumran, Dead Sea, Masada, Sodom & Gomorrah, Arabah

Begin your journey southward at the magnificent ruins of **Beit Shean** where you will tour the impressive excavations of Scythopolis, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis. Travel through the **Jordan River Valley**, the route often taken by Jesus and other Galileans as they traveled to and from Jerusalem. Walk the remains of an ancient community near the shores of the Dead Sea at **Qumran**. In the caves near here, Bedouins discovered what became known as the Dead Sea Scrolls. Take an opportunity to float on the mineral-laden waters of the **Dead Sea**, whose buoyancy and medicinal benefits are world-renown. Stop at **Masada**, the magnificent mountaintop fortress of Herod of the Great, famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion. Take the cable car to the top and peer down at the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Pass by the area believed to be the former home to **Sodom & Gomorrah** and on through the **Arabah** region to Eilat.

Nov. 12 - Leisure Day or Optional Petra (Jordan) Day Trip

Today enjoy a leisure day in the coastal town of Eilat on the Red Sea or take the optional day trip into neighboring Jordan, to see the famed UNESCO World Heritage Site, the rose-red city of **Petra**. (Additional Charge)

Nov. 13 - North to Jerusalem

Beer Sheva, Bet Shemesh, Valley of Elah, Emmaus

Pass through **Beersheva**, where Abraham made a pact with Abimelech (Genesis 21). Here Abraham had dug a well and planted a Tamarisk tree. The area is often referred to as the southern border of Israel - "From Dan to Beersheva". Travel to **Bet Shemesh**, the first city to encounter the Ark of the Covenant on its return from being captured by the Philistines (1 Samuel 6). Continue your journey through the **Valley of Elah**, where David defeated Goliath (1 Samuel 17). View the road of **Emmaus** where Jesus, after His resurrection, met two of His disciples who did not recognize Him until He later broke bread with them (Luke 24:13-35). Check-in to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 14 - Bethlehem & Jerusalem

Church of the Nativity, Shepherds' Field, Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Mount Zion, Caiaphas House, Upper Room

Visit **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2). Enter the **Church of the Nativity**, the oldest continuously functioning church in the world. See the cave where tradition holds Jesus was born. Look out on the **Shepherds' Fields**, where angels spread the Good News. Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). Enter the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus went

to pray after the Last Supper, and was arrested (Matthew 26:36-56). Walk through some of the ancient rooms of **Caiphias' the High Priest's house** beneath the **Church of St. Peter in Galllicantu**. Here, it is believed by many, Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). Stand in the **Upper Room**, near the traditional site of the Last Supper (Mark 14).

Nov. 15 – Jerusalem

Rabbi's Tunnel, Western Wall, Southern Wall Excavations, Cardo, Pool of Bethesda, St. Anne's Church, Antonia Fortress, Via Dolorosa, Church of the Holy Sepulchre

Experience traveling back in time in the **Rabbi's Tunnel**, where foundation stones and other stone work survives from the Second Temple! Touch a part of Herod's Temple as you pray at the **Western Wall**. Explore the **Southern Wall Excavations**, including the **Hulda Steps** and the many **Mikvahs** at the foot of the steps. Continue your journey through the Old City to the **Cardo**. This ancient marketplace has ruins that date back to the Judean monarchy among modern shops. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5:1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Nearby, sing a chorus in **St. Anne's Church** and marvel at its amazing acoustics. Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross," and stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.

Nov. 16 – Jerusalem

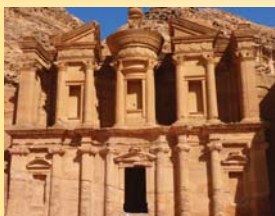
Israel Museum, Yad Vashem, Garden Tomb

In modern Jerusalem, understand better the Jerusalem of Jesus' day with a look at **First Century Model of the City of Jerusalem**, now housed at the **Israel Museum**. Also on the museum grounds, visit the **Shrine of the Book**, where the Book of Isaiah, discovered among the Dead Sea Scrolls, is displayed. Visit **Yad Vashem** & be touched by its poignant exhibits in honor of those who lost their lives during the Holocaust. Finish your day together at the **Garden Tomb** where you can reflect on the agony of the cross, then celebrate the joy & exhilaration of the Resurrection! After dinner, transfer to the airport for the journey home.

Nov. 17 – Return to USA

Return home with a transformed faith and memories to last a lifetime!

Nov.12 – From Eilat, cross the border into Jordan. Wander and wonder at the rose red city of Petra, one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites and one of the new Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Journey back in time through the Siq to see the Treasury Building (made famous by Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade), amphitheatre, and other public facilities and private tombs carved directly into rock! In the distance, the traditional site of Aaron's tomb can be seen. In the town of Wadi Musa, is the spring that tradition holds sprang up when Moses struck the rock. Recross the border into Israel and return to your Eilat hotel for dinner & overnight.

CANCELLATION FEES:

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable.
