

TRAVEL TO IMPACT LIBERIA – SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

Passport & Yellow card

Money: \$250-500 cash, in \$20 bills or less (1 USD=\$70 Liberian). US currency is accepted in most places, although we will change a small amount in Liberian dollars. Credit and debit cards and travelers' checks are not accepted.

<u>Clothes</u>: 3-4 changes of clothing that washes & dries easily, comfortable sturdy shoes such as tennis shoes, socks, sandals or flip flops, underwear, casual clothes/shorts to wear in the apartment, something to sleep in, a rain jacket and one nicer outfit for church. The clothes you bring will get dirty so please refrain from bringing very expensive items.
