<i>This J non-vintage Brut gracefully opens up with crisp lemon peel, honeysuckle and delicate yeast aromas. Upon entry, these notes follow through to a mix of Fuji apple and grapefruit interlaced with toast, caramel and almond flavors on the mid-palate. The acidity adds just enough liveliness and the citrus zest leads to a lingering, warm pear and lush finish. Demonstrating an illustrious combination of yesterday and today, its fresh exuberance showcases layers of depth and complexity.</i>

<i>Schramsberg Brut Rosé (68% Pinot Noir, 32% Chardonnay) is flavorful, complex and dry. The character of the wine is most strongly influenced by bright, flavorful Pinot Noir grown in Carneros, Anderson Valley, and the Sonoma and Marin coastal areas. A few small lots of Pinot Noir are fermented in contact with their skins to add depth and subtle color to this unique sparkling wine. Chardonnay gives spice, structure and length on the palate.</i>

<i>On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark and chiselled. The full taste lingers with the utmost elegance on a sappy, spicy note.</i>

Medium-bodied with crisp acidity and a creamy mouthfeel. This wine was made without any oak influence, nor did any portion of it go through malolactic fermentation.</i>				
Bonny Doon Riesling	2013	San Benito/Monterey		\$32
<i>This wine, provenant of the 2013 vintage, was made from ever so slightly botrytised grapes from the gregarious Ventana Vineyard in Monterey County and the extremely shy-yielding, though hardly coquettish Wirz Vineyard in San Benito County. Remarkably crisp, zinging acidity with enough sweetness (3%ish) to keep it perfectly balanced. In the nose, you find a classic fragrance of kirsch (generally thought of as a signifier of the Rheingau), but maybe also Mirabelle plum and an earthiness that bespeaks the Nabe. Very delicate body; in the mouth, a sort of filigreed, dancing lightness to the wine, impelled, no doubt, by a wonderful, refreshing acidity.</i>				
Thomas Fogarty Skyline Riesling	2011	Central Coast		\$34
<i>Gloriously perfumed nose of star-jasmine, white flowers, quartz and pineapple fruit. The mouth is crisp and laser-like with more flowers, spice, honey and citrus fruit. The palate is dry with just a vague hint of sweetness that adds some depth to the mouth and lifts the fruit.</i>

There are aromas of dark fruit, blackberry, cherry, cassis, plum, vanilla and a slight cocoa and chocolate note.
