<i>Brut Prestige is Mumm Napa's signature sparkling wine. Brut Prestige features fine bright citrus, red apple, stone fruit and creamy vanilla aromas, with hints of toast, honey and gingerbread spice. Its vibrant flavors are balanced by fine acidity and a rich, lingering finish.</i>				
<b>Gloria Ferrer Blanc de Noir</b>	<b>NV</b>	<b>Sonoma County</b>		<b>\$40</b>
<i>Bright strawberry and black cherry aromas with subtle vanilla highlights. Creamy cherry, lemon and cola flavors combine with a lush palate, small, lively bubbles and a persistent finish.</i>				
<b>Gloria Ferrer Brut</b>	<b>NV</b>	<b>Sonoma County</b>		<b>\$42</b>
<i>Delicate pear and floral notes backed by toasty almond. On the palate, one finds lively citrus, toast and apple flavors overlaid with persistent effervescence, a creamy mid-palate and toasty finish. A blend of both Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.</i>

<i>This cuvee has aromas of meadow flowers, pears and citrus peel enhanced with notes of toast, vanilla and spice. The wine is elegantly structured, rich, round and flavorful with the long creamy finish.</i>				
<b>J Cuvée 20 Brut</b>	<b>NV</b>	<b>Russian River</b>		<b>\$70</b>
<i>This J non-vintage Brut gracefully opens up with crisp lemon peel, honeysuckle and delicate yeast aromas. Upon entry, these notes follow through to a mix of Fuji apple and grapefruit interlaced with toast, caramel and almond flavors on the mid-palate. The acidity adds just enough liveliness and the citrus zest leads to a lingering, warm pear and lush finish.</i>				
<b>Schramsberg Brut Rosé</b>	<b>2012</b>	<b>North Coast</b>		<b>\$85</b>
<i>The 2012 Brut Rosé has generous aromas of mixed red berries, orange blossom, and white peach. Its fruitful nose is complimented by notes of shortcake and cream. The palate bursts with flavors of raspberry sorbet, lemon custard, and summer apricot. The wine has a fresh and juicy acidity which drives to a supple, round finish.</i>

<i>A mouthwatering version, with a fine, lacy mousse and delicate flavors of poached apple, blackberry, beeswax and lemon confit underscored by a streak of smoky minerality that echoes on the finish.</i>				
<b>Dom Perignon Brut</b>	<b>2005</b>	<b>Epernay, France</b>		<b>\$325</b>
<i>On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness.</i>

This wine has bright acidity and crisp freshness from the cool, stainless steel tank fermentation, while the subtle oak character from neutral French oak barrels adds body, complexity and depth.</i>

<i>Old World style Sauvignon Blanc meets New World. It's round and plump, yet finishes with cleansing acidity. Notes of herbs and some signature grassiness, flowing into flavors of tropical fruits, lime and gooseberries.</i>

<i>The 2015 vintage produced a vibrant and opulent Sauvignon Blanc. Brilliant pale yellow hues are speared with youthful hints of green, and the aromas are rich and expressive. Grapefruit, green lime, caper, and citrus tones all combine with a lively note of lychee. Flavors of grapefruit, lime and lemon zest, together with a subtle thread of fennel.</i>				
<b>Chalk Hill</b>	<b>2015</b>	<b>Russian River Valley</b>		<b>\$45</b>
<i>A blend of nine different clones of Sauvignon Blanc and Sauvignon Gris barrel fermented in a combination of French oak and stainless steel and primarily fermented with native yeasts. While this Sauvignon Blanc is long on richness and concentration, it also displays the structure and elegance of a cool growing season. The nose is suffused with pineapple, lychee, pear, orange blossoms and thyme. The palate is all lemon, grapefruit, mango and blood orange.</i>

<i>Exotic aromas of passion fruit, papaya, ginger and star fruit leap from the glass, along with layers of grapefruit and melon. On the palate, a lovely Sémillon-driven silkiness provides delicate weight to this wine, while crisp, refreshing acidity and vibrant citrus flavors draw the wine to a lingering finish with notes of Meyer lemon and Kaffir lime.</i>

<i>Mineral-driven fruit from the Sonoma County vineyards and lush tropical aromas derived from the Napa Valley vineyards develops complexity in the glass. Hints of white gold and straw illuminate this wine. The bouquet bursts with mango, guava and gardenias, while the sculpted palate focuses citrus and minerality into lime zest and wet slate. The bright attack, rich full body and refreshingly long finish are redolent of citrus acidity.</i>

<i>Beautifully fresh, fragrant aromas of honeydew melon, grapefruit and guava, with a slight floral note. Full-bodied and concentrated on the palate, with a silky texture, its vibrant melon, citrus and gooseberry flavors are perfectly balanced, leading to a long, succulent finish boasting bright citrus and mineral tones.</i>

This intense and layered wine finishes dry with bright, mouthwatering acidity and distinct minerality.*

<b>Las Positas Vineyards Pinot Blanc 2015</b>	<b>Livermore</b>

*This wine exhibits vibrant aromas of grapefruit, pineapple, lemon and spice. Medium bodied with lime, green apple, lemon peel and mineral on the palate. Fermented in French Oak and Acacia barrels.*

<b>Bonny Doon Riesling</b>	<b>2013</b>	<b>San Benito/Monterey</b>	<b>\$32</b>
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*This wine, provenant of the 2013 vintage, was made from ever so slightly botrytised grapes from the gregarious Ventana Vineyard in Monterey County and the extremely shy-yielding, though hardly coquettish Wirz Vineyard in San Benito County. Remarkably crisp, zinging acidity with enough sweetness (3%ish) to keep it perfectly balanced. In the nose, you find a classic fragrance of kirsch (generally thought of as a signifier of the Rheingau), but maybe also Mirabelle plum and an earthiness that bespeaks the Nabe. Very delicate body; in the mouth, a sort of filigreed, dancing lightness to the wine, impelled, no doubt, by a wonderful, refreshing acidity.*

<b>Thomas Fogarty Skyline Riesling 2012</b>	<b>Central Coast</b>	<b>\$34</b>
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*Gloriously perfumed nose of star-jasmine, white flowers, quartz and pineapple fruit. The mouth is crisp and laser-like with more flowers, spice, honey and citrus fruit. The palate is dry with just a vague hint of sweetness that adds some depth to the mouth and lifts the fruit.*

<i>Carneros aromas of lemon-citrus and white blossom while accentuating the minerality and vivid, fresh fruit flavors of citrus and stone fruits in the wine. Partial barrel fermentation, malolactic and lees stirring create complex layers, imparting hints of oak and wrapping the flavors in a rich, generously textured mouthfeel and elegant finish.</i>
