## SUPPLY LIST

## SUBSTRATE

- Pre-gessoed stretched canvas (I use $30 \times 40$ inch size)


## TOOLS \& MEDIUMS

- Palette, water container, rags and/or baby wipes, water spray bottle
- Catalyst blades and wedges or other palette knives and texture tools
- Glazing Fluid (Optional - I use Golden Glazing Fluid in Gloss)


## ACRYLIC BRUSHES

- Flat area brushes in 1-3 inch size. I use Royal \& Langnickel Flat Brush Set Golden Teacklon.
- Other large brushes I use Silver Jumbo brand Golden Taklon.
- Finer detail brushes in a variety of sizes and shapes. I use Princeton Catalyst, Snap, and Select brushes.


## MARK-MAKING SUPPLIES

- Any kind of pen, pencil, or pastel. I use Faber Castell Pitt Compressed Charcoal, Posca Paint Pen in Beige, and Graphite Pencil.


## ACRYLIC PAINT

A mix of colours of your choice plus black and white. I use both heavy bodied paint and fluid paint. The main colours I use are:

- Burnt Sienna
- Payne's Grey
- Titan Buff
- Dioxazine Purple
- Quinacridone Magenta
- Salmon Pink (such as Matisse Salmon Gum or Golden Titan Mars Pale)
- Pthalo Green
- Benzi Yellow Light
