# SUPPLY LIST

#### SUBSTRATE

• Watercolour Paper. I use Arches 300 gsm cold press in A4 size.

#### TOOLS

- Mixing palette & water container.
- Cardboard or mdf board to tape your paper to (optional).
- Artist masking tape (optional).

#### BRUSHES

- Brushes suitable for watercolour in a range of sizes. I use Princeton Neptune brushes). Round size 4 & 12 are handy to have.
- Mixed-media flat brushes (approx 1 2 inch).

#### MARK-MAKING SUPPLIES

- Salt (any type)
- Cling wrap or you could try bubble wrap, foil, etc.
- Stencil & sponge (optional)
- Posca paint pens or other pens, pencils, or pastels.

#### PAINT

Watercolour paints in colours of your choice. You'll also see me using some acrylic ink, goauche and acrylic paint. The main colours and brands I use are listed below for your info.
