

2004 Tournament

The tournament field consisted of 32 varsity teams, which was a first for any non-state tournament in the Midwest. Only two other tournaments in the country had a larger field than the Pepsi Showdown. Considered by some to be the strongest boys showcase in Illinois, the 2004 field consisted of 32 programs that combined have won 104 sectional titles and advanced to the state finals 52 times. Nine of those programs have won a state title, while 16 others have finished second since the tournament began in 1972. The inaugural two-week, 80-game tourney featured more than 600 players from 24 public schools and eight private schools. More than 90 communities were represented in the Pepsi Showdown. In total, there were 53 different news articles in surrounding newspapers – Chicago Tribune, Daily Herald, Chicago Sun-Times, etc. Comcast taped the title game, and it was broadcasted on Sept. 23.
