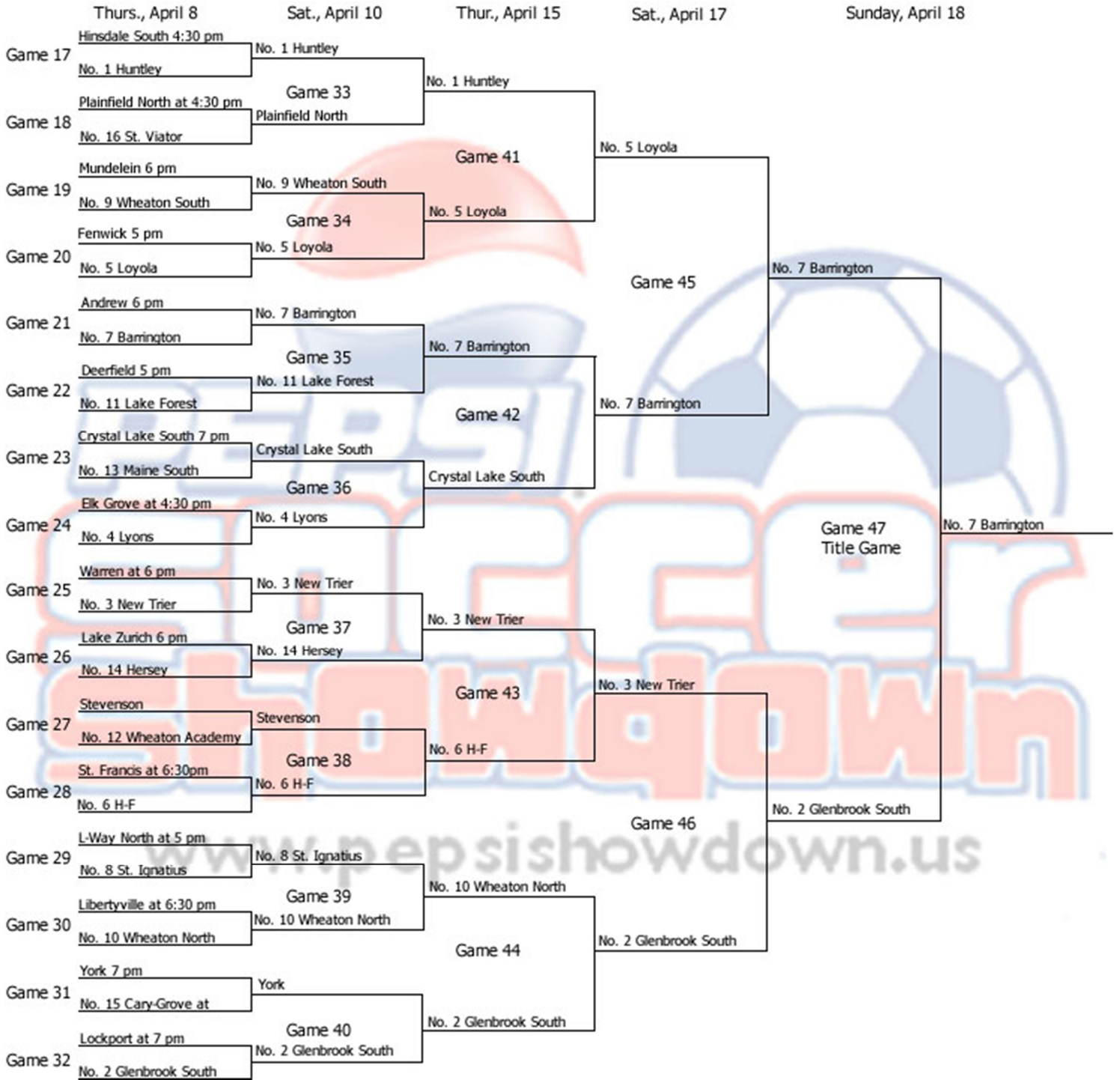


2010 Tournament



The 2010 Pepsi Showdown girls - the largest high school girls soccer tournament in the country - generated more than 76 million media impressions during the 11-day tournament, which featured

116 games and more than 1,000 players from the Chicagoland area in April. According to our media tracking agency, this tournament received more coverage - internet, print, radio and TV - than any other regular season tournament in any sport this year in Illinois. An interesting fact is that if you take the largest high school basketball tournaments from this past year and combine them all together, they still do not surpass the coverage of the 2010 Pepsi Showdown girls.

Below is the 2010 Pepsi Showdown All Tournament Team, led by tournament MVP Molly Pfeiffer from Barrington. The rising star helped lead Barrington to its first Pepsi crown at Toyota Park.
