**Special Grant Opportunity - Become a Partner School in  
The Town Hall Educational Outreach Program  
Academic School Year 2015 – 2016**

The Town Hall is seeking partner schools interested in advancing their students' learning through the arts. Our education department customizes each program to suit your school's curriculum needs and tie it to the New York State Common Core Standards. Teaching artists bring hands-on, interactive art workshops into NYC elementary, middle, and high school classrooms. These activities foster creative expression and critical thinking skills.

For a limited number of NYC public schools, The Town Hall has raised funds to pay two-thirds of the cost of its Educational Outreach Program to support these arts programs. This allows funds for a select number of schools to only pay one-third of the program costs. Choose from the following programs:

**Theatre Making**

Theatre skills focus on using language, voice, gesture, movement, and observation to express experiences and communicate ideas and feelings. Town Hall teaching artists lead students in the exploration of playwriting, improv, scene work, devised theatre and creative drama.

**Dances from Around the World**

Explore your social studies curriculum through traditional dances from around the world including modern, tap, jazz, and hip hop. While learning these dances, students also discover the music, art, geography and history of various cultures. **Please Note:** One dance form will be taught for all classes in one grade.

**Making Music**

Town Hall teaching artists bring the joy of music to your students. Residencies are offered for music beginners that focus on singing and vocal technique or an introduction to music with an emphasis on the basics of rhythm, melody and harmony.

**Technical Theatre Workshops**

Professional technical theatre artists are available to support your school's production. Teaching artists are available to develop students' skills in playwriting, acting, set design and construction, costumes, lighting and sound design and stage management.

**Visual Arts**

The visual arts program offers a rich array of hands-on workshops where students create murals, collages, graphic design, and film making related to the classroom curricula. They discover the proper use of artists' tools, materials, vocabulary and techniques.

**Special Free Performances**

In addition to subsidizing the cost of services, The Town Hall also provides partner schools with free events such as performances during Black History Month as well as discounted and free tickets to special events throughout the year.
