

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF MASTIC BEACH ON OCTOBER 26, 2011
AT THE SENIOR NUTRITION CENTER, 369 NEIGHBORHOOD ROAD,
MASTIC BEACH, NEW YORK AT 5:00PM**

Mayor Breschard led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence

Upon motion made by Trustee Biondi, seconded by Trustee Morrow and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to open the Public Hearing on Local Law of 2011 amending Section 420-3(G)(1) "Leaf Pick Up."

Attorney Prokop explained the change to the current code and that leaves must be placed in bags at curbside for pick up.

Alan Chasinov asked if the village will be providing the bags. Mayor Breschard answered that the village is exploring the possibility of supplying a certain number to residents next year and that Quickway is looking into same.

Frank Cucchiara asked who has responsibility for cleaning leaves on his yard that are falling from a neighbor's tree. It was explained to the resident that it is his responsibility.

Upon motion made by Trustee Biondi, seconded by Trustee Morrow and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to close the Public Hearing.

Upon motion made by Trustee Stiriz, seconded by Trustee Olivo and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to Adopt a Resolution for the purposes of SEQRA pertaining to Local Law of 2011 amending Section 420-3(G)(1) of the Mastic Beach Village Code (see attached).

Upon motion made by Trustee Olivo, seconded by Trustee Stiriz and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to close the Public Hearing.

Upon motion made by Trustee Morrow, seconded by Trustee Biondi and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to Adopt a Resolution for the purposes of SEQRA pertaining to Local Law of 2011 amending Section 420-8 Garbage Collection of the Mastic Beach Village Code (see attached).

Attorney Prokop presented an I.M.A. with the Town of Brookhaven regarding snow and ice removal to the Board. The Board asked if paragraph 15 be added stating that the Village will not incur an additional charge, since services have already been charged to the residents on the current town tax bill.

Upon motion made by Trustee Stiriz, seconded by Trustee Biondi and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to enter into an Inter-Municipality Agreement with the Town of Brookhaven for the purpose of snow and ice removal (see attached).

Attorney Prokop discussed with the Board the possible retention of Sinnreich, Kosakoff & Messina pertaining to the MBPOA lawsuit.

Upon motion made by Trustee Stiriz, seconded by Trustee Morrow and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED to retain Sinnreich, Kosakoff & Messina in regard to the MBPOA lawsuit (see attached).

Trustee Stiriz read to the Board a letter received from Robert Harber regarding a documentary and national recognition.

Mayor Breschard stated that he is looking into hiring a firm for the production of a newsletter and for public relations and that he is awaiting additional quotes.

An update on Village Court was given by Attorney Prokop.

Trustee Stiriz briefly discussed road repair and patching machine company, Dura Patch.
