Chapter 20. CODE ENFORCEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mastic Beach at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. II). Amendments noted where applicable.]

GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 20-1. Creation.

There is hereby created in the Village of Mastic Beach the Department of Code Enforcement.

§ 20-2. Organization; terms of office.

The Mayor, ~~with the consent~~ subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees, may appoint as many code enforcement officers as he or she shall determine to be necessary and may designate a person to be the head of the Department of Code Enforcement. The Department of Code Enforcement ~~shall~~ may also consist of housing inspectors, ~~building inspectors~~ and parking meter collectors of the Village of Mastic Beach upon authorization by the Village Administrator or Mayor. The term of office of the head of the Department and of any officer of said Department, if not otherwise established by law, shall be a period of one year, coinciding with the official year of the Village of Mastic Beach. The head of the Department and any officer of said Department shall, within the time prescribed by law, obtain such basic training, in-service training, advanced in-service training and other training as the State of New York shall require for code enforcement personnel, and shall obtain certification from the State Fire Administrator pursuant to the Executive Law and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

§ 20-3. Powers and duties.

The Department of Code Enforcement shall be responsible for the enforcement of all provisions of the Code of the Village of Mastic Beach and any and all other resolutions, local laws, ordinances and regulations enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Mastic Beach at any time.

§ 20-4. Department head; report to Trustees.

In addition to the general administrative duties incumbent upon all department heads of the Village of Mastic Beach, the head of the Department of Code Enforcement, otherwise known as the Supervisor of the Department of Code Enforcement, shall be directly responsible to the ~~Commissioner of Code Enforcement—Chief Code Enforcement Officer~~ Village Administrator and Mayor. At each meeting of the Board of Trustees, the head of said Department shall make a report to the Board of Trustees. Said report shall include a summary of all code enforcement activities in the period elapsing between the date of the report and the previous report delivered.
