This course is understandably emotionally demanding, the use of sandtray in therapy, and in supervision, is without doubt a potent psychotherapeutic tool. The only way to understand the power of working in this way is to experience it, therefore there is a strong emphasis on experiential learning. The teaching methods will include delivery of theory and provision of notes to take away, ideas for further reading, demonstrations, your own use of sand trays and miniatures, and learning gained from each other. The courses are run in small groups of 6 – 8 participants, some tasks will involve pairing up and exploring the techniques being presented. It is expected that, as qualified professionals, each participant will take responsibility for the level of personal material they share in dyads, triads or group work, and taking responsibility for their own emotional safety. You can always choose whether to use made up scenarios or real material – as long as you take care of yourself. Kirsty Bilski will stress the importance of self-care and any participant can choose to either offer feedback/spectate or to leave the room if required. Kirsty will be available to assist on a one to one basis if required and pays careful attention to any experiential work being undertaken. The safe and ethical use of sandtray is a priority on this course. The course is only open to qualified counsellors and psychotherapists. Groups of students are welcome but separate training dates are arranged on a bespoke basis.

The emphasis throughout the course will be on personal safety, therapeutic holding, ethical and professional care along with continued professional development. Respect and care for yourself in this learning process, will translate into how you therapeutically hold your clients in therapy, and as supervisors in supervision.

Completing this course will give you the knowledge to begin using sandtray in counselling and psychotherapy, however there are member organisations which offer extensive training in sandtray and sandplay which would build on the skills you learn in these four days.
